

# BETTER BOATER BATHROOMS: A Resource for Human Waste Management

There are dozens of rivers in North America for which visitors must pack out human waste at the end of their trip. This is a guide to specific requirements/regulations on pack out rivers. Included are maps showing dump station locations, and links to federal agency websites that contain more detail and lots of additional information about the river and surrounding area.
