2011 Work Plan Accomplishments

Goal 1- Meetings, Workshops, and Float Trips: A SE Chapter has met often in 2011 as we planned for the 2012 Symposium in Asheville. We have met monthly via conference call and in person in Asheville in February, April, and September. Our annual float trip was on the Nolichucky in April.

Goal 2- Publications and Communications: The Chapter webpage will be current and up-to-date with Chapter information by the end of the year.
