The Organization

Idaho Rivers United is a result-driven, campaign-oriented conservation organization formed in 1990 to help citizens protect and restore the rivers of Idaho. About the Position

The Conservation Director is the senior staff position responsible for directing IRU's conservation program. This position requires a deep commitment to the mission of IRU and a strong passion for protecting rivers and the species that depend on rivers for their survival. Additionally, this position requires a broad skillset that includes experience in natural resource, public land, legal, political, communication and social skills.

More specifically, the essential skills required of this position include:

- Strategic thinking and a collaborative mindset
- Excellent writing and public speaking
- A strong working knowledge of state and federal laws and management policies related to rivers, water management, water conservation and energy development
- An ongoing understanding of local, state, regional and federal water politics and the ability to communicate with and/or educate public officials and elected leaders when necessary
- An ongoing understanding of the threats and challenges to Idaho's rivers and streams and the ability to develop creative solutions
- Grassroots organizing skills and the ability to work effectively with volunteers
